



 - Organising events


To be Improved
























Community Service - 2018

Surge's Passport program has a unique global approach and initiates young children (ages 8-11) on the concept of their water footprint.




Project: Upgrade of digital infrastructure at Senses

Location: UAE


The purpose of the project is to finance the replace the digital infrastructure (video surveillance cameras inside Senses center) to monitor the activity of the center.

Water Users: 2,253 people – 1,024 men, 1,229 women


