Next week our guest speaker Danielle Wilson Naqvi, will tell us about herself and her husband who are the founders of The ZB Foundation based in Pakistan who aim to target the uncharted medical area of rare metabolic diseases, especially in the North of the country, and over time, become a compelling soldier for the fight against baby/infant deaths and 3rd world standard pediatric medicine and healthcare facilities. The ZB Foundation have opened their own laboratory in Islamabad where people can finally have the opportunity to provide their babies with a heel prick test (New Born Screening Test) which in the West is taken for granted and ends up saving countless lives. This simple test was not available in Pakistan before we set up the foundation as is provided free of charge to all babies in the country to help diagnose sick babies. The ZB Foundation's pioneering journey is all in the name of the couples late daughter Zahra Beau who died in Dubai at 4 months old - Zahra is the guiding spirit behind this effort to save young lives.
